THE STATUE OF LIBERTY, IN VALENCIA-VENEZUELA, IS CALLED "THE PILGRIM" BECAUSE IT HAS BEEN PLACED IN VARIOUS PLACES IN THE CITY.



IT WAS REMOVED FROM PLAZA SUCRE IN 1930, TO REAPPEAR IN FRONT OF THE CITY'S OLD RAILWAY STATION IN 1936.



IT WAS DESIGNED BY THE SCULPTOR GIOVANNI TURINI, IN NEW YORK. IT ARRIVED IN THE CITY AS A SYMBOL OF BROTHERHOOD BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND VENEZUELA.



THE PILGRIM WAS IN THREE MORE PLACES UNTIL 2014. IT WAS FOUND IN A WAREHOUSE OF THE CITY'S MAYOR'S OFFICE AND SENT FOR REPAIR TO BE EXHIBITED IN A CULTURAL CENTER.



IT WAS PLACED IN FRONT OF THE CAPITOL OF VALENCIA IN 1895, IN PLAZA SUCRE, ON THE OCCASION OF THE CENTENARY OF THE BIRTH OF MARSHAL ANTONIO JOSÉ DE SUCRE.



IN 2017 IT WAS PLACED ON AVENIDA ANDRÉS ELOY BLANCO, IN THE CITY OF VALENCIA, WHERE IT IS LOCATED UNTIL NOW.
