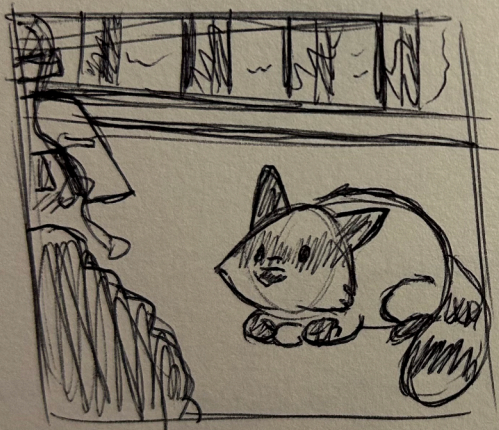

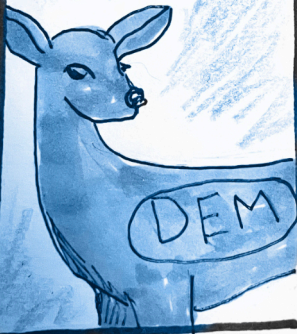

territorial about it



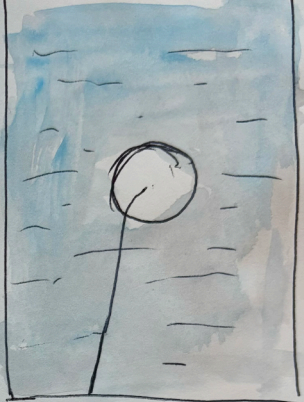
